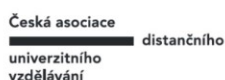
DisCo 2012, and 2014-17 proceedings have already been indexed in the THOMSON REUTERS Web of Science database. DisCo 2018 is currently undergoing the process of evaluation. The 2019 conference proceedings will be sent for evaluation with the aim of their inclusion into the Web of Science as well. Therefore, a primarily scientific approach is required, and the authors' added value should be evident in these papers. Citations of the Web of Science and/or Scopus sources are highly recommended. Selected papers will also be considered for further elaboration and publication in selected magazines, such as AULA, Ricarzionne, Applied Technologies and Innovations or Perspective of Innovations, Economics, and Business.
